# About The Conference

The **Global Road Construction & Safety Conference 2022**, hosted in collaboration with **CSIR- CRRI, Bitumen India Forum, National Highways Builders Federation (NHBF), Construction Industry Development Council (CIDC), International Road Federation (IRF)** and organized by **Rex Fuels** along with our facilitator, **Ease of Doing Business.in** aims to bring together the world's most astute and brilliant minds to debate the issues concerning the road construction industry in India on **November 30th**, at the **Taj Palace Hotel, Delhi (India)**. The growing number of fatalities over the past few years has prompted the building of roads, highways and corridors as well as the execution of legislation relevant to the safety of the roads in India a priority. Despite possessing only 1% of the world's vehicles, India is culpable for 11% of crash-related casualties. One life is lost on Indian roadways every four minutes, depleting the country's GDP by almost 39 trillion USD, or nearly 1.85% of it.

The Government's efforts to dissuade accidents through conventional road safety solutions do not appear to be yielding favourable results, as illustrated by the fact that, despite some promising efforts, 2021 saw the highest number of road fatalities.

Moreover, the government has undertaken infrastructure expansion by increasing the budgetary disbursement from INR 33,414 crores (Financial Year 2015) to INR 1,83,101 crores (Financial Year 2022) in order to construct 100 kilometres of road per day over the next two years. MoRTH/NHAI and highway builders' adoption of sophisticated innovations has played a crucial role in expediting construction projects.

## Key Facts: Indian Road Industry

- > The world's second-largest road network is found in India
- > The total length of India's road network is approximately 6.2 million kilometres
- > The utilisation of the road network in India accounts for about 40% of the total traffic
- > India reportedly constructs about 37 km of road every day
- > The country's budget represents an ambitious goal of constructing 25,000 kilometres of national highways
- > The national highway's length surged by 50% over the past seven years, from 91,000 km to 1,40,000 km
- > To enhance the effectiveness of already constructed highway infrastructure, the BharatMala Pariyojana, announced in 2017, decided to construct nearly 65,000 km of national and economic corridors, border and coastal highways, and expressways
- > A projected INR 5,35,000 crore will be invested in the program's first phase, which will pave 34,800 km of roadways
